

OID TOWNSHIP BOARD
November 13, 2006

Regular Meeting

The Ovid Township Board met at the Township Hall on Monday, November 13, 2006. The following members were present: Sue Miller, Supervisor; Larry Omo, Trustee; Nancy Price, Treasurer; Judy Sabaitis, Clerk; and Ron Sampsel, Trustee. Also in attendance were 6 guests.

The regular meeting was called to order by Sue Miller.

The Board led the guests in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Ron Sampsel seconded by Larry Omo, that the agenda be approved as presented. MOTION CARRIED.

Motion by Ron Sampsel seconded by Larry Omo, that the October 9, 2006 Board minutes be approved as corrected. MOTION CARRIED.

The Treasurer's report was presented including payment of bills. The Board approved the reports and placed them on file. Motion made by Larry Omo seconded by Ron Sampsel, to approve payment of \$317.07 to Quality Quick Print. MOTION CARRIED.

Sue Miller reported that Joe Haas, Township's attorney, is unable to attend this meeting. A special Board meeting is scheduled on November 15th at 5 P.M. The purpose of the meeting is the petition to open road end to lake at Miller Road and Lake Drive. Mr. Haas will review his legal opinion outlined in his letter dated October 3rd.

The Board reviewed the compost issue. Table - no action at this time.

The Board reviewed the Planning Commission's recommendation to amend the fee schedule pertaining to additional fees on those situations where zoning compliancy permits are not obtained prior to construction. Motion by Ron Sampsel seconded by Larry Omo, to approve a fee of three times the permit cost (including the permit cost) for permits not obtained prior to construction **not to exceed \$500**. MOTION CARRIED.

Sue Miller shared Craig Parrish's information on designating Old US 27 as a Heritage Route. A resolution made by Ron Sampsel seconded by Larry Omo, that Ovid Township supports the designation of Old US 27 as a Heritage Route.

Public Comment: Mr. Brown requested information on aquatic weed control.

Judy Sabaitis reported that the November 7th election went very well.

Zoning – Jim Mikolajczyk reported issuing 9 permits, 2 zoning books, and 1 ZBA request.

Assessing – Sue Miller reported that the Special Assessment tax rolls for 2006 are completed. A 2006 tillable land value grid was provided each member.

B.P.W. – No report.

County Commissioner – Commissioner Rubley reported the first hearing was held on the Brownfield Grant. Maple Lawn received no citations during their recent survey, which makes the facility receiving no citations 4 out of the 5 last years. The Commissioners appointed 3 Trustees to the Community Health Center Board, including Jack Shaw, David Smoker and Roger Young.

Cemetery –No report.

Motion made by Ron Sampsel seconded by Larry Omo, to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 P.M. MOTION CARRIED.
