ZONING ORDINANCE UPDATE

The Ovid Township Planning Commission is nearing completion of a revised Zoning Ordinance, which will implement many of the goals and objectives of the newly adopted Master Plan. A public hearing was held on the new Zoning Ordinance in August, and the Planning Commission is making a few final revisions to the text before sending it to the Township Board for adoption.

The Zoning Map is an important component of the Zoning Ordinance. It shows which portions of the township are included in which zoning districts and therefore subject to different sections of the Zoning Ordinance. Changes to the Zoning Map are necessary due to changes that are being recommended in the Draft Zoning Ordinance. To fully understand the possible ramifications of your property, a DRAFT Zoning Map is included on the reverse side of this newsletter.
